the acquired knowledge and expertise into their management system processes and standard practices. When Hill decided to implement the multisite BIM ISO certification for their Middle East and APAC operations, it was very important for them to select a certification company that operates globally to ensure smooth coordination during the initial and follow-up auditing activities.
