Sentinel is the adverse media screening tool in EiQ. It leverages human intervention and machine learning technology to deliver enhanced near-real time supply chain ESG risk monitoring. Sentinel has been used to scan more than 160,000 suppliers and counting.

How does it work?

Sentinel scans the web for insights on key supply chain ESG risks and media controversies related to suppliers and vendors, including but not limited to human rights, environment, bankruptcy, layoffs, wages, working hours and health and safety. The process covers more than 100 languages and returns thousands of results that are filtered and categorised by our machine learning algorithm to detect near real-time reputational and resilience incidents for supply chains.

Information

User provides information to LRQA on a supplier or factory including location, name, local language name, product type, etc.



Sentinel scans hundreds of thousands of public news and information sources (in English and in local languages), including local/ international media, NGO reports, government reports, worker allegations, social media platforms, and other sources.

Screen

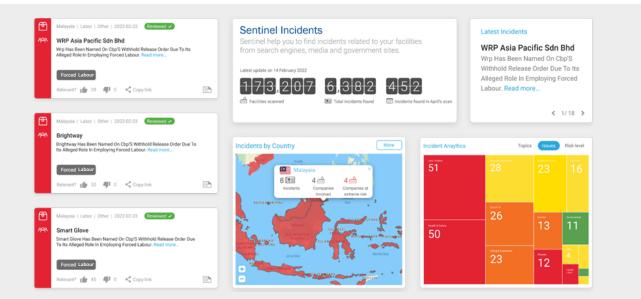
The results are screened by our ESG analysts and then segmented and categorised by industry, region, thematic area, and risk level.





This generates an online report that provides the user with oversight of emerging and existing risks related to a vendor, supplier, factory, farm, logistic company, or other facility type.

Note: We perform Sentinel scans on a monthly basis but can customise based on client demand.
