



Gas Industry Registration Scheme (GIRS) Accreditation Fees 2025-26

The costs of operating the GIRS accreditation scheme is supported by a fee structure for members. The level of fees is agreed by GIRSAP and is as follows:

Fee Structure

Basic Fee [Note – reduced to £2742 for Providers with current NERS or WIRS accreditation] £3698

Plus Scope Fee(s) From Table ¹ below (as applicable)

Plus Scale Fee From Table 2 below (as applicable)

Total fees therefore depend on the scopes required and the size of the Provider being accredited plus the basic fee

11 – 20 employees (as above)	£996
21 – 50 employees (as above)	£1236
51 – 100 employees (as above)	£2006
>100 employees (as above)	£4016

1. Where a Provider operates in a number of regions, managed from local depots/regional offices, they may require each operating base to be assessed. The cost of which would be additional to the fees detailed above. Such additional visits would be charged on a day rate basis.
2. The inclusive site rate is currently £1162 per day. This rate is applicable for surveillance visits

3. Fees are subject to revision in June of each year, next revision date June 2026
