ASC aims to be the world's leading certification and labelling programme for responsibly farmed seafood. The ASC's primary role is to manage the global standards for responsible aquaculture, which were developed by the WWF Aquaculture Dialogues.

LRQA was an early adopter of ASC's Farm Standard and worked across the globe to provide audits for salmon, trout, sea bass, sea bream, mussels, and shrimp producers.

A breakthrough standard in its sector, with wide industry backing, it is designed to minimise the environmental and social impact of commercial fish farms through the promotion of continual improvement. Increasingly sought after by major retailers, ASC certified products can also be traced from producer to plate via the supporting Chain of Custody standard.
