

BOPAS is a risk-based assessment that demonstrates to lenders, buyers, and other stakeholders that homes built using modern methods of construction (MMC) or non-traditional materials will be mortgageable for at least 60 years.

What is BOPAS?

BOPAS aims to standardise best practice across the MMC sector. It focuses on ensuring that accredited organisations have robust systems and procedures underpinned by a risk-based approach that enables them to competently, and safely deliver products or services that meet their clients' requirements.

The accreditation process

The BOPAS assessment evaluates MMC providers against best practice in terms of competency, configuration management, procurement arrangements, and process control, across their business and on a project-specific basis. BOPAS comprises:

 A risk-based process assessment by LRQA of the scopes of design, manufacture, installation and or project management, within the offsite context, assessed against best practice

- A durability and maintenance assessment of 60 to 100 years by BLP Technical Services
- An online database that shows the status of MMC providers and their construction systems. The website also includes details of locations and construction systems of properties manufactured and constructed under the BOPAS scheme.

The assessments are separate and require MMC providers to apply to both LRQA and BLP. Further details of the process can be found in the BOPAS Standard.

Introducing BOPAS⁺

BOPAS⁺ is an extension to the existing BOPAS accreditation. It has been developed to put the focus on the preparedness of MMC providers to positively address the digitisation challenge presented by the net zero initiative, the golden thread, and regulation changes.

BOPAS⁺ aims to monitor BOPAS accredited MMC providers on their journey from the development of digital strategic objectives, through to achieving digital transformation as defined on their digital road map.

When a BOPAS-accredited MMC provider embarks on BOPAS⁺, their position on that journey is marked on a radar diagram that takes into account defined schedules as well as actual achievement, recognising that many MMC providers are at the early stages of their digital road map.
