

Certificate renewal

Three months before your certificate expires, we'll re-audit your organisation's activities to ensure they remain compliant with the requirements of the standard.

Our optional pre-assessment services can be carried out in the form of a Gap Analysis or Preliminary Assessment. One of our expert auditors will assess the readiness of your system, indicating which areas may require further attention before you progress to your

Stage 2 Audit- evaluating your implementation

and effectiveness of your management system in line with the requirements of your chosen standard. If you receive no major non-conformities, approval will be recommended, and you'll receive your certification. The stage 2 audit can be carried out

Annual surveillance audit - staying on track

Your certification will run in three-year cycles. We'll carry out surveillance audits annually to make sure that your management system remains effective, is well-maintained, and delivers continual
