

Legislative drivers for structured digital product information

Recent primary legislation consisting of the Fire Safety Act 2021 and the Building Safety Act 2022 incorporate a common theme that all construction product information related to notifiable building works must be clear, structured, resilient, easily accessible and stored digitally.

Complying with these product data requirements requires a great deal of effort, but can be simplified by using a cloud-based product library, which allows manufacturers to list their products and comply with the requirements more easily.

ActivePlan product library

ActivePlan has produced a cloud-based product content library solution that hosts product data, including manufacturers and their product information. This solution can use either custom data or data templates made available by industry.

The ActivePlan solution was chosen by the Construction Product Association as the data template solution for Lexicon and has been further developed through the Construction Innovation Hub (CIH).

Product information provenance

Product information is produced by manufacturers and then replicated by designers, constructors and third parties. It's relatively easy for a designer to change the manufacturer and product name on a BIM object leaving unaltered, the original product information.

This results in a lack of assurance of the quality and accuracy of information, specifically associated with BIM objects and whether it relates directly to the identified product.

Golden thread compliance

ActivePlan's product library removes the provenance issues ensuring traceability from specification to product, to asset process and tracking product substitution. However, facilities management companies and developers are seeking to resolve the 'golden thread' requirements stipulated in the recent legislation.
